Basildon and Phoenix Swimming Club – Photography Protocol

This photography protocol applies to all parents/guardians/members of Basildon and Phoenix Swimming Club (BPSC) It relates to all images and videos taken on any type of camera or recording device (including mobile phones) and applies to all activities and events run by an ASA affiliated organisation.

It should be acknowledged that although the majority of images taken are appropriate and in good faith, images can be misused and children can be put at risk if common sense procedures are not observed.

Only photographs/videos of your swimmer is permitted, unless permission is granted by the parent/guardian of the swimmer concerned. Particular attention needs to be taken to avoid having other swimmers in the frame when taking images at Galas/Activities/Events, please try and endeavor to make your swimmer the main focus.

The publishing of a photograph of a member under 18, either on a notice board, in a published article, video recording (including video streaming) of a competition ('Publication') should only be done with club/parental consent.

Parents/Members are advised that while the ASA does not support the banning of phones, as children need them to keep in touch with parents, particularly in emergencies, we need to remind you that if mobile phones are taken into changing rooms, the facility to take photos must not be used.

Parents/Members in a volunteering capacity are not allowed to use any image capturing device on poolside.
